



**Prior Information Notice (PIN)
Upcoming Tendering Opportunity
for
the Resurfacing of the John A. Osborne Airport**

The Government of Montserrat (GoM) will be seeking proposals within the coming weeks for the Resurfacing of the John A. Osborne Airport runway.

The runway resurfacing is scheduled to take place over 10 days during a planned full airport closure in November 2020.

A list of major elements to be included within the base Scope of Work is as follows:

1. Runway Resurfacing Works

- Asphalt Milling
- Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Pavements
- Runway Grooving
- Friction Testing (Before and After Construction)
- Pavement Line Markings (2 applications)

2. Airfield Electrical Works

- Remove and Salvage Existing Runway Inset Lights and Install in the New Base Cans to Accommodate New Runway Grade

3. Optional Works

- Taxiway Resurfacing
- Apron Resurfacing
- Supply of an Asphalt Plant to the Government of Montserrat

These works will be overseen and supervised by the GoM and AVIA NG (acting as the Technical Consultant). The Government is seeking value for money and innovative

solutions through this procurement, which will be advertised through the e-sourcing portal (myTenders) and the Government of Montserrat website:
